On 2/28/2020, the new Memorial Christian Hospital (MCH) opened in Malumghat, Bangladesh. This 4-story facility replaces the original 30,000 square foot, 50 bed, 2 operating room hospital with a 120,000 square foot, 120 bed, 7 operating room facility. MCH was originally opened by ABWE in 1966 as a medical outpost and today serves over 50,000 outpatients and provides over 2,000 surgeries annually while serving as a leader in southeast Asia obstetrical care. More importantly than mending broken bodies, the hospital mends broken lives ensuring that every patient hears the gospel of Jesus Christ. Hospital design, planning and construction management were provided by the ABWE Go Construction team.
