Maintenance & Operations @ HBB

Some items Matt was able to work on or oversee while @ HBB in Dec:

- ~Rebuild a mower deck
- ~Repair incinerator fire brick
- ~Convert a storage container for use as medicine cold storage (remove & seal window & install lights, outlet, and HVAC unit)
- ~Remove a dirt pile leftover from guesthouse expansion & grade
- ~Finish gardener storage shed (akata stone, stucco, roof)
- ~PAACS duplex retaining wall and moto parking area
- ~Set PAACS duplex toilets, finish & install cabinets, install handrails
- ~Pass out almost 5lbs of beef jerky to maintenance/gardening staff
